

Call for proposals – Partnership2Gether Beer-Sheva – Bnei Shimon/ Montreal

Partnership2Gether, a network of communities under the auspices of the Jewish Agency, connects 450 Jewish communities worldwide via 45 Partnerships and 10,000 volunteers in Israel and the Diaspora.

For some 20 years, the Beer-Sheva – Bnei Shimon/Montreal Partnership has initiated and guided a diversity of significant projects in the areas of Jewish identity and the relationship between the partner communities.

In preparation for the 2016 budget year, we call on bodies, organizations and associations to submit proposals for projects based on the following criteria:

1. The project takes place within the boundaries of the city of Beer-Sheva and/or the Bnei Shimon Regional Council, and Montreal.
2. The project has a strong Jewish identity component.
3. The project generates a true connection between Beer-Sheva and/or Bnei Shimon and the Montreal Jewish community.
4. The project supports the formation of interpersonal connections and relationship building through people-to-people initiatives (whether physical or via electronic media).
5. The project will yield proven results that can be measured and evaluated based on the stated outcomes in your proposal.
6. The project is expected to have additional sources of funding and be sustainable post Partnership support.
